| | He spent 25 years teaching—first at Yale and then at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill—and then for 16 years directed a program of public policy research on Latin America, as part of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars. |
| | He has been active in only one tobacco-related trial: <i>Widdick v. Brown and Williamson</i> . Under cross-examination in that case Tulchin declared that he had billed the tobacco companies for \$90,000. He charged \$250 an hour for his work as an expert judicial witness. ¹ |
