Short Description	<p>Parssinen has published <i>Secret Passions, Secret Remedies: Narcotic Drugs and British Society, 1820-1930</i>, and <i>Webs of Smoke: Smugglers, Warlords, Spies and the History of the International Drug Trade</i>. Using memoirs and recently discovered documents, Parssinen has published the first-ever book on the little-known plot that collapsed following the Munich conference of 1938: <i>The Oster Conspiracy of 1938: The Unknown Story of the Military Plot to Kill Hitler and Avert World War II</i>.</p> <p>In a deposition taken for <i>Sulcer v. R.J. Reynolds</i> in September 2010 Parssinen declared that he charged \$135 an hour for his research on tobacco-related issues. He furthermore stated that he had made around \$360,000 with litigation-driven work for the tobacco companies.¹ One year later, in a deposition pertaining to <i>McCray v. R.J. Reynolds</i> Parssinen disclosed he had made \$450,000 as an expert judicial witness for the tobacco industry.² The following year Parssinen acknowledged in an expert report submitted in <i>Rodehaver v. R.J. Reynolds</i> that his hourly rate for research was \$135, and that for testimony \$200.³</p>
